



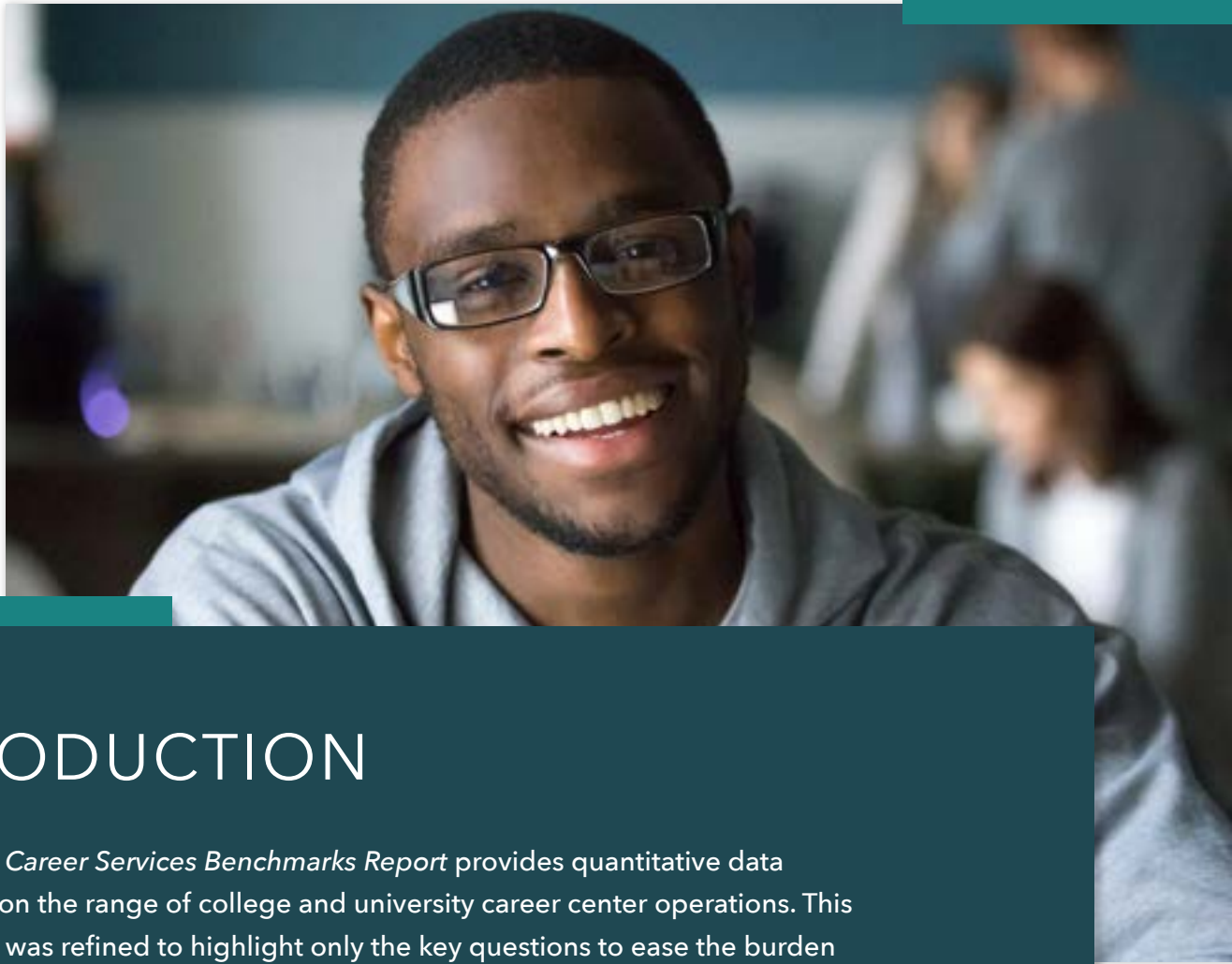
# NACE 2024-25 CAREER SERVICES **BENCHMARKS REPORT**

# INTRODUCTION

The *2024-25 Career Services Benchmarks Report* provides quantitative data and analysis on the range of college and university career center operations. This year's survey was refined to highlight only the key questions to ease the burden on our career services members. NACE provides the results in figures throughout the report, while discussing important relationships, yearly trends, and insights.

# HIGHLIGHTS

## OFFICE & REPORTING STRUCTURE

- Over the past five years, career centers have mainly been centralized operations that report to student affairs. Academic affairs joins student affairs as a top reporting line.

## BUDGETS

- Budgets for the 2024-25 academic year have increased across the board since 2022-23. The median overall budget has increased by 21% in the last two years. Personnel costs remain around 87% of the total budget and non-personnel costs are 13%.
- Median in-person career fair fees for the 2024-25 academic year have resumed to pre-pandemic amounts for private-sector employers and are just shy of the amounts previously set for nonprofit and government employers.

## STAFFING

- Total office FTE has increased to a median of 7.0 for the current academic year, as opposed to 6.5 in the last report.
- Nearly 70% of career centers are offering staff the ability to work from home in 2024-25. This figure has trended upward since the pandemic. Other benefits seeing slight increases from 2020-21 are staff retreats, shortened Fridays, and volunteer time off.

## SERVICES AND APPOINTMENTS

- Since the pandemic, NACE has tracked virtual and in-person appointments. While in-person appointments have grown since 2021-22, they are still below 2019-20 levels. However, the median number of virtual appointments is higher than in 2019-20.
- The median number of students who career services assisted with finding an internship has increased to 156 from 124 students in 2021-22, although the mean has dipped again, continuing a downward trend since 2015-16. The median number of workshops provided has lost ground by a total of eight since 2021-22.

## CAREER FAIRS

- During 2023-24, the mean number of in-person career fairs has increased by 1.2 fairs and the median by 1.0 fairs. The figures are now more consistent with what was seen prior to the pandemic. Meanwhile, the median number of virtual career fairs is consistent with 2021-22.
- The number of organizations in attendance at in-person career fairs has slowly been recovering to pre-pandemic levels. On the other hand, the median number of organizations that attended virtual career fairs has decreased by 37 since 2021-22.
- The number of students attending career fairs is following suit. The number of students attending in-person is climbing back, while the number of those attending virtually has decreased.
- For the 2024-25 academic year, 93.9% of respondents indicated they will hold career fairs in person, while 33.2% of respondents will hold a virtual career fair and 6.3% of respondents will hold a hybrid fair (simultaneously in person and virtual).

## ON-CAMPUS INTERVIEWS

- Much like the decrease in attendance for virtual career fairs, virtual on-campus interviewing has decreased sharply since the last report.

## DATA USAGE

- Similar to 2021-22, approximately 44% of career centers collect the demographic data of those using career center services.
- Approximately 28% of career center leaders provide these demographic usage rates data to their direct report.
- The main reasons given for collecting these data are to identify underserved students and to refine programming.

## CAREER INTEGRATION

- Using a badging or passport type of program to incentivize career development is growing, albeit slowly, in higher education.
- Approximately 43% of institutions provided a stipend for underpaid or unpaid internships in 2023-24. The main source of these funds is donations or alumni, and one-third originates from institutional funding.

## COMPETENCIES

- Nearly three-quarters of responding institutions indicated they were implementing career readiness competencies in their college, campus, or university.
- The primary efforts used to implement career readiness competencies are ways in which institutions reach students directly. These include classroom presentations (75.3%), collaboration with faculty (72.7%), and first-year student experiences (58.7%).
- Seventy-three percent of respondents reported they knew of NACE's validated Competency Assessment Tool. When asked if they have already or plan to implement the tool for the 2024-25 academic year, 29.3% reported they have done so or plan to.

## TECHNOLOGY AND AI

- The use of AI as an assistive tool is expanding. Currently, 59.3% of career center staff use AI when providing students with career services.
- It is more common for career services to present workshops on how to use AI to staff than to students.







# APPENDIX

## ABOUT THE SURVEY

NACE collected data for its 2024-25 *Career Services Benchmarks Report* from October 9, 2024, to November 30, 2024. NACE surveyed its member institutions, resulting in 551 respondents, which translates to a 29.3% response rate. The participating schools that chose to be listed as respondents can be found below.

In previous reports, we have broken out many results by Carnegie Classification. Because we provide these data in the dashboard that accompanies this report, NACE believes it would be more useful to provide more of a longitudinal view of trends where possible.

A few notes about the data in this report:

- Overall statistics were calculated based on the number of respondents for that question, as every question was optional.
- The sum of percentage breakdowns may not equal 100 due to rounding or, in cases where the sum substantially exceeds 100, because respondents were asked to select all options that apply.
- In general, the results included in this report reflect data based on the 2024-25 academic year. The exception to this is the data related to services, which is for 2023-24.
- In these data, a few large schools usually pull the mean upward; thus, the median is generally a better reflection of the data.
- Responses to questions with low response rates should be interpreted with caution.

Note: Compensation data for career center positions are reported separately in NACE's 2023-24 *Career Services Compensation Report*, which includes base salary, formal salary range, change in salary from previous year, years of tenure, bonus information, and selected benefits.
